2. Request For Street Closure - Parade Of Lights

Mitchell Main Street and Beyond would like to request a parade permit, street closures and No Parking for Tuesday, December 3rd, 2019 for the Parade of Lights beginning at 7:00pm.

The following street closures and no parking beginning at 4:00pm on Tuesday, December 3rd:

- Main Street - Railroad Ave through 9th; 9th Ave from Rowley to Lawler
- Railroad Ave from Rowley to Kimball
- City Parking lot just north of The Depot Pub & Grill

Float line up for parade will be at 1st through Railroad Ave on Main Street, including two blocks east on Railroad Ave and 1/2 block west on Railroad, allowing entrance opening to The Depot.

In addition, it is requested that the streetlights on Main Street be turned off at 7:00pm (start time) for the duration of the parade (approximately 8:00pm).
