Assistant Police Chief Mike Koster called the meeting of the Traffic Commission for the City of Mitchell to order at 6:00pm on Monday, August 19th, 2019 in the Mitchell City Council Chambers.

AGENDA

Assistant Police Chief Mike Koster requested approval of the **Agenda** for this meeting August 19th, 2019. Councilperson Allen made a motion to approve the agenda. Councilperson McCardle seconded the motion with all members voting aye.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. AKG requests permission to bring heavy equipment to the AKG 100 Year Celebration, which will be held on September 14th at Patton Young Park. AKG is in the process of confirming the specific equipment that will be on display. At this time, it is requested that the 400 and 500 blocks of south Edgerton St. be closed from 7:00am until 6:00pm with no vehicles parked on either side in order to display this equipment during the celebration. Should the equipment set-up not require both blocks on the day of the event the closure will be modified as necessary.**

Karol Von Eye with AKG addressed the group and informed them that AKG will have an IH 8250 Combine with corn head and a CTX 100 Skid Steer on display; however, AKG is in the process of finalizing the rest of the equipment that will be on display during the celebration. Karol will submit a list when the equipment is confirmed. The combine weight is 46,979 and the skid steer is 2,958. It was asked if there were any concerns with the equipment weights on the street. Kyle Croce with Public Works said there is not. Councilperson Rice stated that he lives in one of the three houses impacted by the closing of the two blocks on Edgerton. He stated that when there are events in the park there are 34 cars parked in those two blocks. If the two blocks are closed people attending the event will lose access to the pavilion and will have to walk further. He commented that it could be more difficult to get the catered food in with the street closed. Councilperson Rice also stated there are three driveways that exit on to Edgerton so equipment cannot block the street completely. Councilperson Rice stated he has no problem with the event; however, there would be some logistics to figure out. Attendees will have to come from the other side of the park. Karol stated that employees would have a flyer with information.

Councilperson Rice made a motion to approve the request. Councilperson Smith seconded the motion with all members voting aye.

Meeting Adjourned at 6:08pm.

The next Traffic Commission meeting is scheduled for Monday, September 16th, 2019. The time will be announced at a later date.
